Mandatory Language for Public Notice

Triggered Source Monitoring and Reporting Violation:

Ground Water Rule

City of Redwater PWS 0190008 failed to collect the required number of triggered source bacteriological samples for fecal indicator monitoring of the ground water system during AUG 2015 and JULY 2014. This monitoring is required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's "Drinking Water Standards" and the federal "Safe Drinking Water Act," Public Law 95-523.

Triggered source samples (raw water samples) are used to monitor water quality and indicate if the water is free of fecal indicator bacteria. Following a positive routine total coliform result in our distribution system, our water system is required to submit one triggered source sample for every active ground water well. Failure to collect all required triggered source samples is a violation of the monitoring requirements and we are required to notify you of this violation.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: <corrective actions>

**THE WELLS ARE NO LONGER IN SERVICE AND WE ARE STRICTLY DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM NOW AS WE PURCHASE WATER FROM TEXARKANA WATER UTILITIES.**
