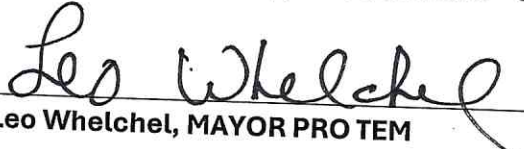
FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS/FUTURE BUSINESS
