

Public Notice to Boil Water

THIS BOIL WATER NOTICE IS FOR **RESIDENTS LOCATED ON CR 1213 AND 991 ESTATES** THAT PURCHASE WATER FROM THE CITY OF REDWATER.

Due to the water pressure going below 20 psi within the water distribution system on February 5, 2026, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required the City of Redwater public water system (ID#0190008) to notify customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, individuals may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the public water system officials will notify customers that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice. We hope to tentatively issue a boil rescind notice by **February 10, 2026.**
